Autism and Asperger's: Effects on the Workplace

According to studies, the diagnostic rate of autism has increased up to 700% since 1990, and Asperger's diagnoses are also increasing. As more employees are dealing with an autistic child, there can be a significant impact on the workplace. In addition, many individuals with Asperger's are currently in the work force and may need assistance coping with the stressors.

Dr. Koltun will present options for employees who have family members with these disorders and discuss how EAPs can help people with Asperger's function within the workplace.
