PRESENTER: *Sam R. Hamburg, PhD*
Dr. Hamburg is a psychologist in private practice in the Chicago Loop. He is a lecturer in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Chicago's Pritzker School of Medicine, and is also on the adjunct faculty of The Family Institute at Northwestern University. Dr. Hamburg is the author of *Will Our Love Last?* (2000), a book about compatibility and marriage.

PROGRAM: *Communication vs. Compatibility: Implications for Couple Therapy*
Ever since the early Post-WWII period, marital problems have been regarded as essentially communication problems. In this presentation, that idea will be critically examined, evidence for it will be assessed, and an alternative view will be presented: *that marital problems are not communication problems but compatibility problems.* A compatibility-based model of conjugal love will be presented and its implications for couple therapy will be explained.
