Merge onto I-94W via the ramp on the left.

Exit at Old Orchard Rd (exit 35)

Turn right onto Old Orchard Rd

Turn right onto US 41S/Skokie Blvd

Turn left onto Golf Rd

Turn left onto Gross Point Rd (You will pass Lieberman Center on your left)

End at 9779 Gross Point Rd – turn right at the Church Parking Lot and board the CJE shuttle

From the North

Merge onto US-41S/Edens Expressway toward I-94 E/Chicago

US-41 S/Edens Expressway becomes I-94E/Edens Expressway E.

Exit at Old Orchard Rd (exit 35)

Turn left onto Old Orchard Rd

Turn right onto US-41S/Skokie Blvd

Turn left onto Golf Rd

Turn left onto Gross Point Rd (You will pass Lieberman Center on your left)

End at 9779 Gross Point Rd - turn right into the Church Parking Lot and board the CJE shuttle
