**PRESENTER:** **Paul Fitzgerald, PsyD**  
Paul Fitzgerald is the Director of Master's Counseling Training at Adler School of Professional Psychology and a board member of NIEAPA. He has worked in the Employee Assistance field for 22 years, as an EAP counselor and clinical case manager, and was Clinical Director of a national EAP program for five years. He currently teaches in the Master's in Counseling and Organizational Psychology program at Adler School.

**PROGRAM:** **Promoting the EAP Profession to Early Career Human Services and HR Professionals**  
Many mental health clinicians are unfamiliar with the nature of EAP work and tend to see it as a form of reimbursement rather than a core technology. This program will provide EA professionals with ways to “sell” the core technologies of EAP to students and early career professionals, and generate interest in Employee Assistance as a career, a clinical and organizational approach, and a philosophy of service delivery in the current economic and professional environment.

**From I-90/94 (North of Chicago)**

- Take I-90/94 toward Indiana/Chicago Loop into downtown Chicago.
- Take ext 51E towards E. Monroe St. (.1 mi.)
- Turn left on W. Monroe St. (.9 mi.)
- Turn left onto S. Dearborn (.1 mi.)
- The Adler School is on the right (17 N. Dearborn)

**From I-90/94 (South of Chicago)**

- Take I-90/94 toward Wisconsin into downtown Chicago.
- Take ext 51E towards E. Monroe St. (.1 mi.)
- Turn left on W. Monroe St. (.9 mi.)
- Turn left onto S. Dearborn (.1 mi.)
- The Adler School is on the right (17 N. Dearborn)

**From I-55 (Southwest of Chicago)**

- Take I-55 (North) toward Chicago.
- Take ext 292A toward Wisconsin onto I-90 W/I94 (3 mi)
- Take ext 51E towards E. Monroe St. (.1 mi.)
- Turn left on W. Monroe St. (.9 mi.)
- Turn left onto S. Dearborn (.1 mi.)
- The Adler School is on the right (17 N. Dearborn)

**Parking**

The Adler School does not have on-site parking. However, there are commercial parking garages close to campus that offer discounted parking with validation. Simply ask our reception desk for a parking validation card when you visit, and they will provide it for you.

- **Wabash Randolph Self Park**  
20 E. Randolph (.45 miles away) (312) 656-4713  
Daily \$12 to park up to 12 hours
- **Lake and Wells Self Park**  
177 N. Wells (.65 miles away) (312) 656-4713  
Daily \$9 up to 12 hours; Parking validation card must be used to receive discount.

**Public Transportation**

**Train Lines:**

- Orange Line (from Midway airport) / Green / Brown / Purple Lines: Exit at Washington/Wells. Walk 3 blocks east to Dearborn, and make a right. The school will be on the left.
- Blue Line (from O'Hare airport): Exit at Washington. Walk to south to the Adler School at 17 N. Dearborn.
- Red Line: Exit at Lake. Walk south approximately 1 block to Washington and make a right. Walk one block west to Dearborn, make a left. The Adler School will be on your left.
