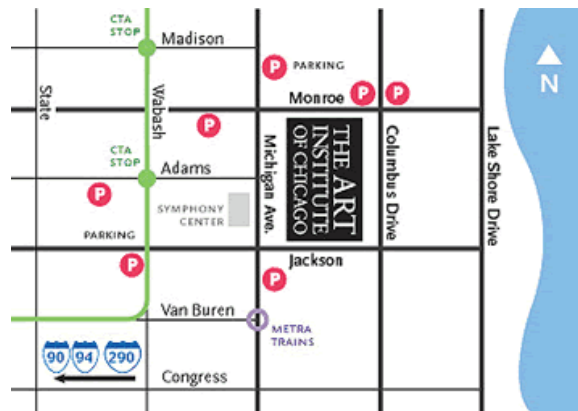

**The meeting will be held at the Art Institute of Chicago in the Millennium Park Room on the east side of the building. You must enter the building on Columbus Drive (NOT Michigan Avenue). There is parking directly across the street in the Millennium Park Parking Lot (See directions below).**

**Please stop at the NIEAPA desk in the Columbus Drive lobby of the Art Institute.**

**YOU MUST ENTER THE MUSEUM ON COLUMBUS DRIVE:**

The entrance is about 200 feet south of the corner of Columbus and Monroe. There is a tan-colored awning that says "Student Group Entrance." This is the entrance you must use. If you have trouble finding the entrance on the day of the program, call (773) 209-2425.



**DIRECTIONS:**

**Using Public Transportation**

The Art Institute is located just one block east of the Loop and is easily accessible via the city's "El" train system. The Brown, Green, Orange, Pink, and Purple lines all stop above ground at Adams/Wabash, in front of the museum. The Red and Blue lines stop underground at Monroe, just a few blocks away. A number of bus lines also stop in front of the museum. Currently, El fare is \$1.75 per adult with an El card; \$2 with cash. Visit the Chicago Transit Authority's Web site for route, schedule, and fare details.

Metra is Chicago's commuter rail transit system. The Van Buren and Millennium stations stop underground just 1–2 blocks away on Michigan Avenue. Visit Metra's Web site for route, schedule, and fare details.

**Driving and Parking**

Recommended parking is in the Millennium Park or East Monroe Lots, both of which can be entered from Columbus Drive, just north of Monroe Street.

**Driving to the Art Institute via Expressways:**

**From Indiana and South Suburbs**

Indiana toll road (90) to Chicago Skyway to Dan Ryan Expressway (90, 94) to Congress East (Loop exit). East on Congress to Columbus Drive. North (left) on Columbus to Monroe. Enter Parking lot just north of Monroe.

**From Wisconsin and North and Northwest Suburbs**

Edens Expressway (94) into Kennedy Expressway (90, 94) to Loop, exit Monroe Street east. East to Columbus Drive. North (left) on Columbus. Immediate entrance to parking garage.

**From West Suburbs**

Eisenhower Expressway (290) east (290 becomes Congress Parkway in Loop) to Columbus Drive. North (left) on Columbus to Monroe. Enter Parking lot just north of Monroe.

**From Southwest Suburbs**

Stevenson Expressway (55) to Lake Shore Drive (41). North to Jackson Blvd. West on Monroe Street (left turn) to Columbus Drive. North (right) on Columbus and immediate entrance to parking garage.
